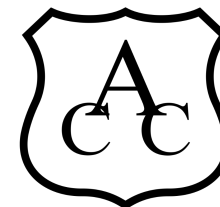

Capsizing	Participants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drowning • Secondary drowning • Hypothermia • Injuries from sharp objects in the water 	Session Organiser to ensure that there are competent paddlers to assist with recovery of participants from the water. Session Organiser to ensure that there is a bank based supervisor with throwline to assist in recovering participants from the water. Paddle Leaders to supervise areas where volunteers are working to minimise accident risks.	L	None
Injuries from tools	Participants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cuts from foliage, discarded fishing tackle, rubbish 	Paddle Leader to ensure that all participants are briefed in appropriate usage of any tools and equipment. Paddle Leader to brief all participants on the importance of leaving adequate space to avoid injuring others. Paddle Leaders to supervise areas where volunteers are working	L	None

Cuts from debris	Participants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cuts from foliage, discarded fishing tackle, rubbish 	Paddle Leader to ensure that all participants wear gloves. Paddle Leader to brief all participants to be vigilant for sharp hazards. Paddle Leader to brief all participants to use tools instead of hands where possible.	L	None
Strains from lifting	Participants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Strains, sprains & breaks 	Paddle Leader to brief all participants on the dangers of heavy lifting. Paddle Leader to brief all participants on safe lifting techniques (bend knees not backs). Paddle Leader to advise splitting loads into smaller and more manageable chunks. Paddle Leaders to supervise areas where volunteers are working to minimise accident risks.	L	None
Slips, trips and falls	Participants and general public: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Strains, sprains & breaks 	Participants to take reasonable measures to ensure that all areas are kept tidy at all times to remove trip hazards. Participants to ensure careful movement on the bank, particularly in wet, muddy, or slippery locations, and when carrying equipment. Participants to ensure that boats and equipment are positioned tidily and off pathways when on the bank. Paddle Leaders to supervise areas where volunteers are working to minimise accident risks.	L	None
Spread of invasive species		Session Organiser to ensure that all boats and equipment are cleaned after the session.	L	None

Notes:

This risk assessment is intended to cover: inexperienced participants; and risks specifically from the environmental project activities. This is to be used in addition to the usual paddling risk assessment for the relevant craft and environment.
